Nord's Notes

~ A word from our president ~

Huxley in 1953

I found this article – "Huxley – Where the first Norwegians Settled" on an internet search written by Mrs. Ora Hansen in 1953.

The town of Huxley is situated in the south part of Story County, one mile northwest of where the first Norwegian pioneers formed a ring with their caravan, to spend the night on June 7, 1855, when they migrated to the Huxley area from Libson, IL.

The Huxley site was owned by Thor Olson who was bought out by the Chicago Milwaukee, St. Paul Parkway land Company, which laid out the town of Huxley in February, 1882.

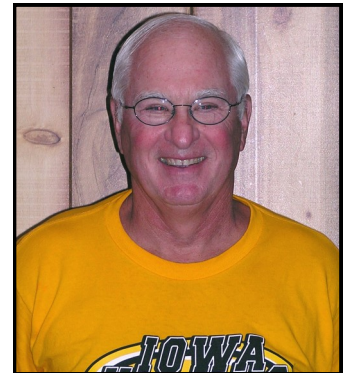
In 1890 there was a population of 50 to 75 Norwegians. Thor Olson and Knudt Mikkelsen, under the firm name of Olson and Mikkelsen, was the town's first business place from 1882-1885. Jacob Stenson was the town's first blacksmith. Jacob was also postmaster from July 1882 to May 13, 1890. He also built the town's first house. A. L. Kloster and N. J. Thompson started a general merchandise store on August 25, 1884. Mr. Kloster was appointed postmaster on October 1, 1890 and was postmaster until his death in 1916.

The Bank of Huxley was established on May 6, 1901 with L. O. Larson, president, A. V. Eklund, vice-president, Ed Johnson, Ben Johnson, E. T. Johnson, T. A. Richardson, N. R. Sydnes, S. Tesdall, Andrew Nelson and A. L. Kloster, directors, and E. S. Tesdall, cashier.

The Huxley Farmers Creamery was established in the years 1896-97. Palmer Saveraid was employed in the creamery for 20 years, 1933-1953, and was the manager of the creamery.

The Huxley Mutual Telephone Company was started in 1902 in the A.E. Ness Hardware Store. The first two operators were Siri Oswald and Minnie Eide. The officers in 1953 were Wier Sydnes, president; Olem Testell, secretary and treasurer; Ole Brendeland and S.B. Sheldahl, boards members; and Charles Busby was manager and lineman. Mrs. Lillian Busby and Ella Heggen were the operators.

O. J. Saveraid bought the drug store from Anfin Apland on June 6, 1904. In 1953, O. J. had operated the drug store for 49 years.

Other businesses at the beginning of the 19th century were: A.E. Nass, hardware; Ole Dobbe, implement store; Sydnes and Chelsvig, livery stables; John Valen and Sons, grocery and butcher shop; H.O. Peterson, restaurant; H. J. Thompson, general merchandise; A. Gunderson, automobile business; Ole Heggen, shoemaker; Peder Seversike, blacksmith; Faltin Kalsem, real estate; Martin Hansen and Lars Fjelland, butcher shop; and O.M. Johnson, grain and lumber.

On November 24, 1919 a fire destroyed five businesses on the east side of main street including Roy Elliott's restaurant; Lem Sabo's, harness shop and post office; Saben Sydnes's, livery barn; W. R. Richardson and Andrew Wenos's implement store and an opera house.

Roy Elliot started in the restaurant business on December 22, 1909 when he purchased it from J. R. Sydnes. The restaurant was located at the corner of what now is Memorial Park.

When the building burned, Roy started a restaurant on the west side of the street and continued in business until May of 1937. Elmer and Charlotte Dobbe took over the restaurant on the west side of the street where Diane Lande's salon, Main Ave Salon, is now.

Roy Elliott and Orville (?) went into the oil business and had a Shell Station on the west side of highway 69 where the new car wash is located.

L.L. Kampley was a home decorator in Huxley for 51 years. Also, Weir Sydnes, mayor of Huxley for the past 17 years, was a home decorator for 52 years.

Albert Johnson was the postmaster from 1920 to 1946. Mrs. Albert Jacobson was acting postmaster from 1940 until 1949 when Robert Christopher was appointed as postmaster.

Huxley Fire Department Chief was led by Palmer Saveraid; Assistant Chief, Beverly Hill; Captain, Tilden Fjelland.

Population of Huxley in 1942 was around 400. The Huxley school was consolidated in 1918 and a new school house was built in 1921. Superintendent of school was Earl Stephenson and a staff of 18 teachers in 1953.

The Huxley Community Club was organized Dec. 8, 1941. On February 16, 1942, permanent officers were elected: President, Dr. O. F. Freed; Vice President, Weir Sydnes; Secretary and Treasurer, Orville Kalsem. Other active members were John Larson, Sophus Berhow, Dennis Ingram, and R. B. Helland. Projects accomplished through the years include:

- (1) Community Shelter House erected in 1947
- (2) sponsored 12 annual horse shows with entrants from five surrounding states
- (3) Story County FFA Tractor Rodeo was held in Huxley
- (4) other community projects were sponsoring merchant baseball teams, Christmas lighting and decorations and the planting of a permanent Christmas tree in the park.

World War II Huxley Hero

One of the World War II heroes was Burton Rullestad of rural Huxley. He was born October 23, 1908 to Mr. & Mrs. Esten Rullestad just northeast of Huxley.

Burton was an army veteran of World War II and was awarded the silver star, with the citation reading as follows: For gallantry on action against the enemy from June 2, 1945 to June 14, 1945. During the defense of Reiporsweiller, France, the machine gun action in which Pvt. Rullestad was an ammunition bearer, received the brunt of the determined enemy attacks. Facing the intense enemy fire, he adequately supplied sufficient ammunition for the gun. When all members of the section, except for Pvt. Rullestad and another man, became casualties, the two men managed the gun, bringing deadly fire to bear against the enemy. Largely due to the gallant efforts of Pvt. Rullestad, the enemy attack was repulsed and a heavy toll of enemy lives were taken. The courage and steadfastness in the face of intense enemy fire displayed by Pvt. Rullestad reflects highest credit of himself and the armed forces of the United States.

Burton died August 21, 1969, at the Vets Hospital in Des Moines.

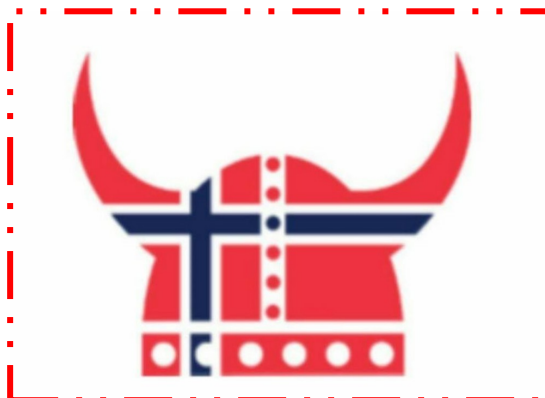
